- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Let's go on the
- 2 record.
- 3 This is the time set for the prefiling
- 4 conference for Harquahala Flats B-E-S-S project.
- 5 Start with appearances. Mr. Crockett?
- 6 MR. CROCKETT: Good morning, Chairman
- 7 Stafford. Jeff Crockett appearing on behalf of the
- 8 applicant, which is Harquahala Flats Energy Storage, LLC.
- 9 And joining me on the Zoom call this morning are James --
- 10 James Jackson, Alex Simons, and Anna Galanis with NextEra
- 11 Energy, the parent company of the applicant. And then
- 12 we've got Colin Agner with SWCA, who is the outside
- 13 consultant on the project.
- 14 CHMN STAFFORD: Excellent.
- Do you anticipate any intervenors in this
- 16 case?
- 17 MR. CROCKETT: At this time we do not.
- 18 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. What about public
- 19 interest so far?
- 20 MR. CROCKETT: I think the public interest
- 21 has been pretty minimal so far, consistent with other
- 22 projects. This is in western Maricopa County, Harquahala
- 23 Valley, as you are very familiar with. We haven't had
- 24 much -- much public interest in the project at all to
- 25 date.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And I've got two
- 2 prefiling exhibits, 1 and 2. They are both maps. Second
- 3 one shows the locations of the proposed signs. Those are
- 4 both admitted.
- 5 Do you want to tell us about those,
- 6 Mr. Crockett?
- 7 MR. CROCKETT: Yes, Chairman Stafford. And
- 8 I will note this project is a little bit unique in that it
- 9 is a battery storage only project. And the battery
- 10 storage facility sits right off Interstate 10. The
- 11 gen-tie is approximately 2.9 miles long. It goes west and
- 12 then straight south to the APS Delaney Substation where we
- 13 interconnect.
- 14 You can see on Prefiling Exhibit -- Well, I
- 15 guess you can see on both of them, but looking at
- 16 Prefiling Exhibit 2, where we have our proposed sign
- 17 locations, you can see there is a development there just
- 18 south of I-10 and south of the battery storage project.
- 19 We have posted signs at the north and south end -- or we
- 20 are proposing to post signs at the north and south end of
- 21 that project. And then Signs 2 and 3 on the map would be
- 22 over on the gen-tie on the western side of the -- Well,
- 23 it's kind of the center of the map, but heading down to
- 24 the Delaney Substation. And then the -- Sign 3 is on the
- 25 highway and I'm -- The name of the highway at this point

- 1 is kind of escaping me.
- Colin, do you remember?
- 3 MR. AGNER: Salome.
- 4 MR. CROCKETT: That -- that's it. Thank
- 5 you.
- 6 THE COURT REPORTER: I'm sorry, say it
- 7 again. Salome?
- 8 CHMN STAFFORD: Yes. It's S-A-L-O-M-E.
- 9 MR. CROCKETT: Yeah. So proposing four
- 10 signs, which we think is -- is adequate in the area to
- 11 advise the public of the project.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. Excellent.
- Now, you'll get me a draft notice of hearing
- 14 in Word when you file something?
- MR. CROCKETT: Yes, we have that.
- 16 And Chairman, we are -- we are planning to
- 17 file the application this afternoon after we finish this
- 18 prefiling conference. So I've got a draft of the notice
- 19 that I will send over once I have the docket number.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay.
- 21 MR. CROCKETT: And I'll send that over to
- 22 Tod. That will be this afternoon.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay.
- MR. CROCKETT: Hopefully we will get that
- 25 filed this afternoon, along with the list of affected

- 1 jurisdictions.
- CHMN STAFFORD: Ah. Nice segue. So which
- 3 are Maricopa County. Other than that?
- 4 MR. CROCKETT: Maricopa County, Maricopa
- 5 County Department of Transportation, Arizona State Land
- 6 Department, and then the fourth entity I've not dealt with
- 7 before is the Arizona Fire and Medical Authority, which
- 8 provides the fire protection services to the area where
- 9 the project's located.
- 10 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And so you will get
- 11 the notices to them.
- Now, for the publication of the notice in
- 13 the papers, what's -- which papers and what publication
- 14 dates are you looking at?
- 15 MR. CROCKETT: Colin, could I ask you to
- 16 respond to that question?
- 17 MR. AGNER: Sure.
- 18 Chairman Stafford, we've coordinated with
- 19 the West Valley View, which is a newspaper publication in
- 20 circulation in the area. We -- If we could have the
- 21 notice of hearing back to us today we can publish in the
- 22 West Valley View this Wednesday, which is tomorrow, and
- 23 next Wednesday. If we can't get the notice of hearing
- 24 back by today we probably would need to publish in the
- 25 Arizona Republic to meet the publication requirements.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: So it's -- Next Wednesday
- 2 would be the 4th?
- MR. CROCKETT: Correct.
- 4 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And then what's
- 5 the anticipated hearing date?
- 6 MR. CROCKETT: It is January 13th.
- 7 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. Well, you
- 8 know what, you should probably just send over the draft
- 9 before you get the docket number.
- 10 MR. CROCKETT: Okay. I'll send that -- I'll
- 11 send that to Tod as soon as we finish our call.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay, great. Then we'll
- 13 have that prepped to go and then all you have to do is --
- 14 we will have to do is fill in the docket number.
- 15 Yeah, because I'm sure it will cost you
- 16 quite a bit less to do it in the West Valley View and not
- 17 the Arizona Republic. Right?
- 18 MR. CROCKETT: That's true. Yes.
- 19 MR. AGNER: Correct, Chairman Stafford.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And so the
- 21 hearing, where do you anticipate holding the hearing?
- 22 MR. CROCKETT: The hearing will be at the
- 23 Hampton Inn & Suites in Goodyear on Litchfield Park Road.
- 24 It's a place we've been at before. And we've -- we've
- 25 made arrangements for that week to be there.

- 1 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. So we are setting it
- 2 for the 13th through the 18th, I guess.
- MR. CROCKETT: Correct.
- 4 CHMN STAFFORD: Shouldn't take that long.
- 5 MR. CROCKETT: Actually the 17th, I believe.
- 6 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And you will have
- 7 lodging for the out-of-town committee members?
- 8 MR. CROCKETT: Yes, we will.
- 9 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Now, have a plan
- 10 for a tour. It will be in the procedural order, too, but,
- 11 yeah, plan on one. Again, since it's -- What's the
- 12 distance from -- from the Hampton Inn to this project
- 13 anyway?
- 14 MR. CROCKETT: Let me ask either James or
- 15 Alex to answer that question. I'm guessing it's about
- 16 40 miles, but --
- 17 MR. JACKSON: Chairman Stafford, I don't
- 18 have that off the top of my head but I can research it
- 19 really quick.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay, great.
- 21 MR. CROCKETT: And Chairman, I think it
- 22 would probably be looking at about a three-hour round-trip
- 23 tour.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay.
- MR. AGNER: That's correct, Chairman

- 1 Stafford. And Jeff. I think it's roughly a 30- to
- 2 40-minute drive from the hotel to the -- you know, a stop
- 3 that we would propose for the tour.
- 4 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. A tour
- 5 ordinarily wouldn't be necessary, but we'll see what kind
- 6 of public comment we get. The thing is, with that
- 7 development down to the south of the project, I mean,
- 8 it's -- it's closer to the -- to the BESS, but it's -- the
- 9 line is going the opposite direction, from what I'm
- 10 looking at on the map.
- 11 MR. CROCKETT: That's correct.
- 12 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. So we'll see -- A
- 13 tour is not inconceivable, but I would venture that it
- 14 would be unlikely.
- 15 MR. CROCKETT: We will be prepared with a
- 16 tour. We will have a tour map and itinerary, as well as
- 17 arrangements for a bus that can take the committee on the
- 18 tour.
- 19 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. So if we do do
- 20 one it will be on that Tuesday morning; right?
- MR. CROCKETT: That's what we are planning
- 22 for, yes.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. And Tod,
- 24 what do we have for the prehearing conference date?
- MR. BREWER: We have this scheduled for

- 1 January the 6th at 11:00, Mr. Chairman.
- 2 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And you intend to
- 3 file it today, you said?
- 4 MR. CROCKETT: Yes.
- 5 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. You probably
- 6 wouldn't get the procedural order till after the holiday,
- 7 but I think you'll be all right.
- 8 Yeah, have the draft CEC filed by the time
- 9 of the prehearing conference.
- Now, we'll do public comment at 5:30 on the
- 11 first day. Do you anticipate much public comment? I
- 12 guess the -- the folks that live in that area, is it -- Is
- 13 that developed or is it slated to be developed?
- 14 MR. CROCKETT: I believe there are some
- 15 residences there. Maybe James or Alex can provide a
- 16 little more detail on how many -- approximately how many
- 17 residents we have in that area.
- 18 MR. JACKSON: So to the -- to the east of
- 19 the project site there are -- a staked-out development
- 20 area with roughly I would say maybe five to ten houses in
- 21 the vicinity. So while it is -- there are roads for more
- 22 houses, there are roughly a handful.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. But that -- it's
- 24 platted out to develop, what is it, single-family homes
- 25 out there?

- 1 MR. JACKSON: I believe so, Chairman.
- 2 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay, thank you.
- 3 All right. Now, what the -- Oh, do you
- 4 anticipate any public officials wanting to make public
- 5 comment?
- 6 MR. CROCKETT: We don't at this point, no.
- 7 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. And what's the permit
- 8 status? I assume the transmission line is a permitted use
- 9 in Maricopa County.
- 10 MR. CROCKETT: The trans -- That's correct.
- 11 And I believe that they will be filing -- the applicant
- 12 will be filing for their conditional use permit for the
- 13 BESS in early December, or December sometime.
- 14 Is that -- James, is that correct?
- MR. JACKSON: That -- that is correct. We
- 16 are targeting December 16th. That is the first permit we
- 17 have to file before we can file for the T line.
- 18 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And there's no
- 19 federal nexus? No cities, towns?
- 20 MR. CROCKETT: That's correct.
- 21 CHMN STAFFORD: No highway crossings? Just
- 22 state road crossings, looks like.
- MR. CROCKETT: We just have two MCDOT road
- 24 crossings.
- 25 CHMN STAFFORD: Indian School and?

- 1 MR. CROCKETT: I'm not sure what two road
- 2 crossings those are.
- James, do you happen to have that
- 4 information?
- 5 CHMN STAFFORD: It looks like 451st Avenue
- 6 and Indian School Road looking at the map.
- 7 MR. JACKSON: That's correct, Chairman.
- 8 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay. All right. And I
- 9 assume you'll have Peaks Audio to handle all our Wi-Fi and
- 10 technological needs.
- 11 MR. CROCKETT: Yes. Those arrangements have
- 12 been made.
- 13 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. And you'll have
- 14 standard tablets and Kindles for us to make everything
- 15 electronic work properly?
- MR. CROCKETT: Yes.
- 17 CHMN STAFFORD: Excellent.
- 18 And the filing fee for this I am assuming
- 19 was a thousand dollars.
- 20 MR. CROCKETT: That's correct.
- 21 CHMN STAFFORD: You know the Commission is
- 22 obligated by statute to pay the costs of reporting and
- 23 transcribing any application hearing, as well as the
- 24 actual and necessary expenses incurred by the committee
- 25 members in connection with their participation in

- 1 committee meetings from the filing fee. Costs and fees
- 2 exceeding that amount may, with the applicant's consent,
- 3 be incurred by the committee and charged to the applicant.
- 4 Does the applicant consent to pay the
- 5 Commission those costs in excess of the filing fee?
- 6 MR. CROCKETT: Yes.
- 7 CHMN STAFFORD: Excellent.
- 8 All right. So we'll have the standard
- 9 three-day turnaround for the transcripts.
- 10 Is there anything else we need to cover
- 11 before you file today?
- MR. CROCKETT: That is everything on my
- 13 list, Chairman.
- 14 CHMN STAFFORD: Tod, anything else? I think
- 15 we got it.
- 16 MR. BREWER: No, Mr. Chairman. That's it.
- 17 Thank you.
- 18 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. Excellent.
- 19 MR. CROCKETT: And Chairman --
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: Yes.
- MR. CROCKETT: -- we will hand-deliver -- we
- 22 will hand-deliver a copy of the application to your office
- 23 this afternoon.
- 24 CHMN STAFFORD: Okay, great. And then,
- 25 yeah, just email the Word version of the notice of hearing

- 1 so I can get that today and then you will be able to --
- MR. CROCKETT: Do you want me to go through
- 3 Tod or do you want me to --
- 4 CHMN STAFFORD: Yeah, send it to Tod.
- 5 MR. CROCKETT: Okay.
- 6 CHMN. STAFFORD: Yeah, send it to Tod.
- 7 Yeah, and then -- Yeah, so we'll make sure you get that
- 8 ready so you can get the publications done in the West
- 9 Valley View.
- 10 I think that should cover everything. Have
- 11 a happy Thanksgiving.
- 12 MR. CROCKETT: Hey, you do the same.
- 13 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. I look forward
- 14 to -- to getting that, the application. And then we'll
- 15 see you in January.
- MR. CROCKETT: Thank you.
- 17 CHMN STAFFORD: Actually, I will see you
- 18 before that but on a different matter.
- MR. CROCKETT: Yes.
- 20 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. You got
- 21 everything you need, Jill?
- 22 THE COURT REPORTER: Yes. Thank you.
- 23 CHMN STAFFORD: All right. With that we're
- 24 adjourned.
